

Detailed Claim Information (DCI) Reporting

- The State of New Jersey is adopting the redesigned DCI program (Circular Letter #1774).
- **About DCI Reporting**
DCI data consists of indemnity (lost time from work) claims. DCI uses a state-specific random sampling process to identify reportable claims, which are used for a more refined analysis of workers compensation. This data supports statistical analysis of the costs and characteristics of indemnity claims.
- **Implementation Plan**
Under the redesigned DCI program, the initial Reported to Insurer (RTI) Date will be September 2009. Claims will be valued as of March 2011 and are due to be reported to the NCCI by June 2011. Subsequent DCI reports will be due in one year intervals, up to the 11th report.
