- Total record length is 387 bytes including the 26 delimiters starting after the “Employer Name” field and ending after “Carrier Name” field.
- Some of the Zip Codes may include all 9 digits or no Zip Code at all. A dash “-“ will be between the 5-digit Zip Code and the 4-digit add-on code when the 4-digit add-on is available. Otherwise, the last five bytes of the Zip Code field will be blank. The entire Zip Code field will be blank when it is not available.
- All valid dates will contain slashes and are defined MM/DD/CCYY.
- Experience Rating Date fields will be blank when the risk is not experience rated.
- The file is in **policy expiration year, month and day** order.
