MANUAL AMENDMENT BULLETIN #506

To: All Bureau Members and Subscribers

Re: Classifications Layout Change

BACKGROUND

The Commissioner of Banking and Insurance has reviewed and acknowledged an amendment to the New Jersey Workers Compensation and Employers Liability Insurance Manual ("Manual") layout of Part 4, Section 1, "Classifications". Presently, classifications are alphabetized by phraseology and, in certain instances, by industry segment. This approach frequently disassociates classifications with multiple phraseologies. In these instances, the same classification code is listed multiple times throughout the Section to reflect the alphabetic variation of the code's phraseologies. In order to consolidate code presentation, while also carrying forward directive footnotes, this update lists classifications in numeric order. Additionally, classifications that address federal coverage have been listed separately in the Manual, and this reordering brings these classifications forward to Part 4, Section 1, with no adjustment to the existing numeric ordering of these codes in Part 3, Section 6, "Maritime or Federal Employments". Finally, the new presentation of the Section includes updated language in instances where antiquated terminology is used.

MANUAL CHANGES

Part 4, Section 1, "Classifications" of the Manual is updated to reflect these changes. The Manual changes are attached, which become effective July 1, 2022.

- Subject to the above and the specific provisions of each classification, that single classification shall be applied which most accurately describes the principal (in terms of payroll expended) operations. In no instance shall the acreage planted, the value of crops or any standard other than payroll expended be used in determining the applicable classification.

Domestic workers employed by a business, other than a business described by Code 0917, are classified to the appropriate domestic code.

1320F GAS OR OIL LEASE OPERATOR—NATURAL GAS & DRIVERS Separately rate: erecting or dismantling of derricks, drilling, installation or recovery of casing; well shooting; cementing, tank building; topping operations or gasoline recovery.

1320F OIL OR GAS LEASE OPERATOR & DRIVERS Separately rate: erecting or dismantling of derricks, drilling, installation or recovery of casing, well shooting, cementing, tank building, topping operations or gasoline recovery.
